2" Floor Construction

5-Layer Laminated Construction

1. Galvanized steel underbelly

- Coated with Zinc Oxide to prevent metal from rusting and is harder to cut or rupture.
- Helps keep rodents and other pests from gaining access to interior

2. 1½" Welded tubular steel framing

- Stronger than aluminum (aluminum is a low-density metal and when used in foundations it is more prone to failure compared to steel) 3" X 8" metal plates welded at 24" intervals over the Heat Duct channels to prevent soft floors.

3. 1½" High compression block foam insulation


- Increases R-Value and insulation of motorhome. Thicker block foam than many other manufacturers providing better insulated RVs

4. ½" floor decking

- 2 layers of ¼" decking with staggered seams
- Staggering seams prevents dead spots and air gaps since no seams run through entirety of floor

5. Linoleum (SHAW Flooring)

- Slip Resistant
- Stain Resistant
- Cold Crack Resistant
- Resistant to Mold and Mildew

Mirada uses Noble Select Sidewalls

The Noble Select sidewalls have a High Gloss gelcoat finish that will prevent fading and help maintain its look for years to come. They have 3X the insulation properties and are 20% lighter than wood substrate sidewalls. This creates more cargo carrying capacity in our motorhomes and allow them to be used in more extreme climates. Noble Select sidewalls come with a 3 year warranty unlike most other sidewalls with a 1 or 2 year warranty. Most other manufactures uses Noble Classic sidewalls that have a Luan backer



Even-Cool / Cool-Stream Ducting

The Mirada comes standard with dual 15,000 BTU A/Cs with heat pump air conditioning units, and a 5.5 kw NPS Yamaha powered gas generator.

The Mirada has CoolStream® residential ducting. This is an air conditioning system that is installed in the built-in channels of the crowned, vacuum-bonded roof. The insulated ductwork has an antibacterial coating that resist mold and mildew build-up. Radius corners provide maximum efficiency

Other Motorhome manufacturers utilize molded block Styrofoam insulation with the built-in channels for their airflow. However, many do not install ductwork. Styrofoam is comprised of thousands of miniscule circular beads that have microscopic pores. Over time, those pores will accumulate dust particles. Air conditioning is nothing more than displacing moisture from the inside of the coach and transferring it to the outside which means moisture flowing freely through the coach and interacting with dirt and dust. Over time, this can have an adverse affect, especially for customers that are very sensitive with allergies.



MIRADA is Standard Equipped with Two GE 15K AC's with Built-In Heat Pumps.

HOW DOES A HEAT PUMP OPERATE?

- These are two diagrams side by side of how the two systems function:
 - Air Conditioner as a cooling unit on the left
 - Air Conditioner as a heating unit on the right
- Notice the compressor drawing in both the cooling and heating modes



The reversing valve Rotates 90°. This changes the direction of the flow of the refrigerant. It goes in the opposite direction and this is the reverse of the cooling cycle. Instead of absorbing heat from inside the motorhome it absorbs heat from the air outside the motorhome and transfers that heat to the interior. Now the indoor coil has become Condenser and the outdoor coil has become Evaporator

Notice that the heat isn't generated by a gas furnace. It is just moved (or pumped) from the outside air to inside the motorhome. This is why the Heat Pump is so popular in moderate climates. It also functions effectively in colder climates when the outside temperature is 38° to 40° or warmer. You don't need to operate the furnace when the weather cools off. Because of the reversing valve you can use the same electric system as both an air conditioner and a heater!

 - Coachmen orders chassis from Ford with longer wheelbases than many competitors. The longer wheelbase allows more weight to exist between axles and less overhang resulting in a better handling motorhome.



Determining the Towing Capacity of a MIRADA MOTORHOME

Every MIRADA Gas Class A motorhome has a tow hitch rated at 8,000 lb. That **DOES NOT** mean it can tow 8,000 lbs. The tow capacity of a **fully loaded** Mirada is determined by subtracting the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) from the Gross Combined Weight Rating (GCWR).

Example 1: a fully loaded **29FW MIRADA** on the **18,000** lb. GVWR chassis has a GCWR (Gross Combined Weight Rating) of **23,000** lb.

Therefore, this **fully loaded** 29FW Mirada has a towing capacity of 5,000 lbs.

Example 2: a fully loaded **MIRADA** on the **22,000** lb. GVWR chassis has a GCWR (Gross Combined Weight Rating) of **26,000** lb.

Therefore, these **fully loaded** Mirada's have a towing capacity of 4,000 lbs.

So, how much weight **beyond** this capacity can a motorhome legally tow?

The difference between the actual weight and the GVWR will determine how much **more** the motorhome may legally tow.

Load the motorhome as it will be used and have it weighed. Typically, the average couple will load the motorhome to between 800 and 1200 lbs. So, if motorhome has 3,000 lbs. CCC* and we load it with 1,000 lbs. of cargo, we can tow an additional 2,000 lbs. In example 2 above, the customer can legally tow 6,000 lbs.

Regardless of the hitch rating, always calculate the legal towing capacity of the motorhome, remembering...

NEVER Exceed the Hitch Rating!

NEVER Exceed the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR)!

NEVER Exceed the Gross Combined Weight Rating (GCWR)!

Inverter Technology

Our generators are unlike anything that has ever been released on the market. The biggest single differentiator is the use of Inverter Technology on our unit. Our proprietary inverter uses a 5% pure sine wave that allows for cleaner, more efficient, stable power. This is the first time inverter technology will be available for RV onboard power generation. A generator with an inverter still produces AC electricity, just like a conventional generator. However, a rectifier is used to convert the AC electricity to DC power, and the DC power is “cleaned” and “smoothed” out by capacitors. In the final step giving this technology its name, the DC power is then converted back into clean AC power, resulting in consistent, reliable, “clean” power!

Why Purchase Inverter Technology

Inverter technology is widely recognized for offering cleaner, more stable power. In the electronic age, this couldn't be more important as many new electronic devices are using microprocessors, which are sensitive to the type of power used. When using unclean power, you run the risk of damaging the device or facing user errors/malfunctions. Your laptop, phones, gaming consoles, blue-ray players, and now kitchen devices will benefit substantially from the use of inverter technology. The result is more efficient power use and cleaner power!







The Solar Controller regulates

- **Bulk Charge**, battery voltage has not yet reached boost voltage and 100% of available solar power is used to charge the battery
- **Boost Charge**, when the battery has recharged to the boost voltage setpoint, constant – current regulation is used to prevent heating and excessive battery gassing.
- **Float Charge**, after the battery is fully charged in Boost voltage stage, the controller reduces the battery voltage to Float voltage set point. When the battery is fully recharged, there will be no more chemical reactions and all the charge current transmits into heat and gas at this time.




